ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Upon the annexed Affirmation of Jarman D. Russell, sworn to on April 12, 2024 (the “Russell Affirmation”), counsel for Citibank, N.A., and upon the pleadings and proceeding heretofore had herein;

LET all parties, or their attorneys, show cause before the Hon. Melissa A. Crane at IAS Part 60, Room 647, of the Supreme Court of the State of New York for the County of New York, at the Courthouse located at 60 Centre Street, New York, New York, on April __, 2024 at _____ a.m./p.m., or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard, why an Order should not be made and entered:

(a) Granting the [Proposed] Partial Severance Order and Partial Final Judgment concerning the SASC 2003-3XS, SASC 2003-36XS, and SASC 2003-S1 trusts, filed contemporaneously with the Russell Affirmation; and

(b) Granting such other and further relief as this Court deems just and proper.

SUFFICIENT REASON APPEARING THEREFOR, let service of a copy of this Order to Show Cause, together with the papers upon which it is based, be made upon all appearing counsel for the parties, no later than April __, 2024 by e-filing and by email, and such service shall be deemed sufficient; and it is further

ORDERED that opposition papers, if any, to the entry of said [Proposed] Partial Severance Order and Partial Final Judgment concerning the SASC 2003-3XS, SASC 2003-36XS, and SASC 2003-S1 trusts are to be served at least two business days prior to the return date of this motion, by e-filing and by email upon all appearing counsel for the parties, and such service shall be deemed sufficient.
